THE JAMES MOIR MEDAL

The medal shall be awarded to the best student who has completed a course in any branch of chemistry at **NQF level 8 (Honours or Postgraduate Diploma)** at a South African University or University of Technology, and achieved a **credit-weighted average final mark of at least 75%**.

The medal shall be known as the **James Moir Medal of the South African Chemical Institute**. The medal is struck in bronze and bear the Institute's name and crest on the obverse, and the name of the medal together with the name of the recipient and the date on the reverse. One medal shall be available for award annually for each University and University of Technology in the Republic of South Africa. The medal shall be accompanied by a suitably inscribed scroll.

Past medalists are ineligible for nomination for a second award (in case of a second qualification within the NQF level 8).

The Council may, at its discretion, suspend this award in any year in which there are no suitable candidates.

PROCEDURE FOR NOMINATION/APPLICATION

The merits of the work of candidate may be brought to the notice of the Council by the Head of the Department who may recommend ONE candidate from the institution.

Nomination requirements:

Nominations should include the listed documents in the following order:

- (1) The completed James Moir Medal 2024 Nomination Form signed by the Head of Department, and
- (2) the academic transcript of the student containing the NQF level 8 results.

The above documents should be merged into ONE PDF, which **should be named as: SURNAME_INITIALS_JAMESMOIR2024.pdf**

Nominations should be received by the Institute no later than **31 May 2024**.
